

SEALED BIDS for Supplying to the Department of Public Works, Highway Division, Crushed Stone for a one year period beginning May 1, 2019 and ending April 30, 2020 will be received at the Dorchester County Council Office, BID BOX, 501 Court Lane, Room 108, Cambridge, Maryland 21613 until 10:00 A.M. on the date specified below for Bid Opening, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read.

The County will have the option to extend the contract for two additional one year periods at the same prices, subject to the approval of the supplier with a 30 day notice prior to the expiration date of the contract.

DELIVERY SCHEDULE

Bidders shall be prepared to deliver daily quantities in a minimum amount equal to approximately 300 tons. Bidder shall be held responsible for the cost of any additional staff time needed to accommodate lesser daily delivery schedules. Cost of providing additional county staff will be deducted from invoices.

The successful bidder will be notified on the exact stockpile area and of the exact tonnage at each point at such time when the material is ordered. The successful bidder will be required to begin delivery to any site within two weeks of notification, however, this should not be construed to mean that the Dorchester County Department of Public Works, Highway Division will begin to order within this period. It is contemplated that the major portion of this material will be ordered between May 1, 2019 and November 1, 2019.

GENERAL PROVISION MATERIAL SPECIFICATION

All material shall meet current Maryland State Highway Administration specifications for crushed stone except graduation of # 10 should contain a minimum of 9% - 200 mesh material.

A certificate of inspection, by a reputable testing company, will be required if so requested by the Dorchester County Highway Director.

BIDDING FORM

All bids shall be submitted on the "Standard Bidding Form" for Dorchester County Department of Public Works, Highway Division, or a reasonable facsimile thereof.

TIME FOR FILING/BID OPENING

All bids shall be submitted on or before 10:00 A.M., Wednesday April 17, 2019 to the Dorchester County Council Office BID BOX; County Office Building, 501 Court Lane, Room 108, Cambridge, Maryland, 21613. No bids will be accepted after 10:00 A.M., Wednesday April 17, 2019. Envelopes should be clearly marked **SUPPLYING THE DORCHESTER COUNTY DEPARTMENT PUBLIC WORKS, HIGHWAY DIVISION CRUSHED STONE.**

Bids will be opened at that time and publicly read thereafter in Room 110.

Bids will then be reviewed by the Public Works Director and a recommendation will be submitted to the Dorchester County for their approval.

AWARD OF CONTRACT

Award of bid will be made on or about May 7, 2019.

BID BOND

All bids shall be accompanied by bid bond or a certified check in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000). Such checks shall be returned to unsuccessful bidders upon award of the contract.

PERFORMANCE BOND

The bid bond or certified check of the successful bidder will be retained until such bidder has filed a satisfactory performance bond with the Dorchester County Department of Public Works, Highway Division, in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000).

RESPONSIBILITY OF BIDDER

Failure to comply with any of the requirements included in this proposal will be deemed just cause for cancellation of the contract by the Dorchester County Department of Public Works, Highway Division and for the pro-rata assessment against the performance bond for having the contract quantities supplied by others.

TAX EXEMPTION

Dorchester County, being a political subdivision, is exempt by law, from applicable excise and sales taxes. The successful bidder must have the ability to bill the County for fuels free of excise and sales taxes.

The County reserves the right to reject any and all bids, waive formalities, informalities and technicalities therein, and to take whatever bid they determine to be in the best interest of the County considering the lowest or best bid, quality of goods and work, time of delivery or completion, responsibility of bidders being considered, previous experience of bidders, or any other factors they deem appropriate.
